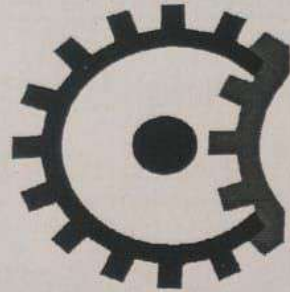

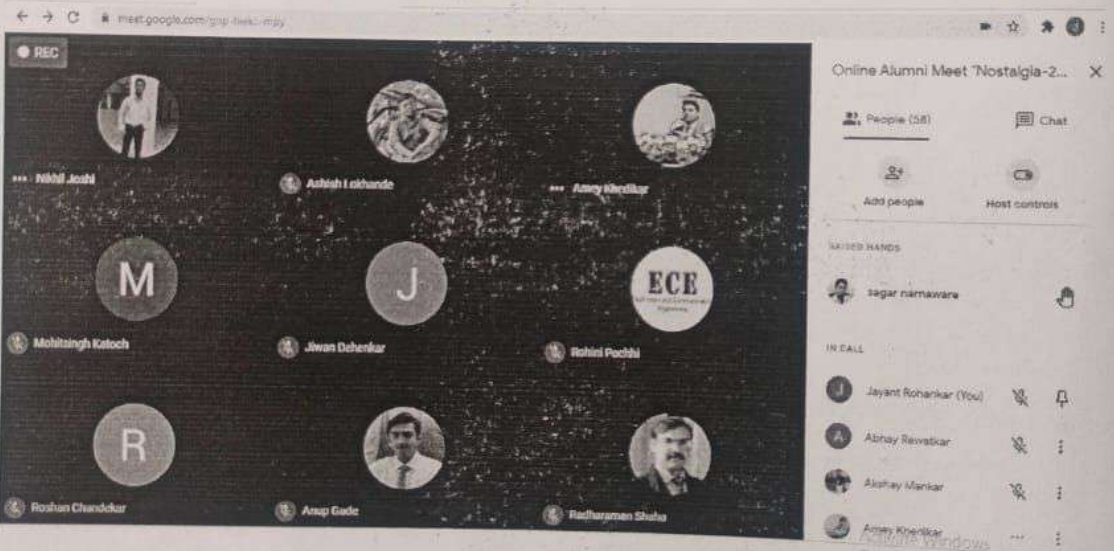
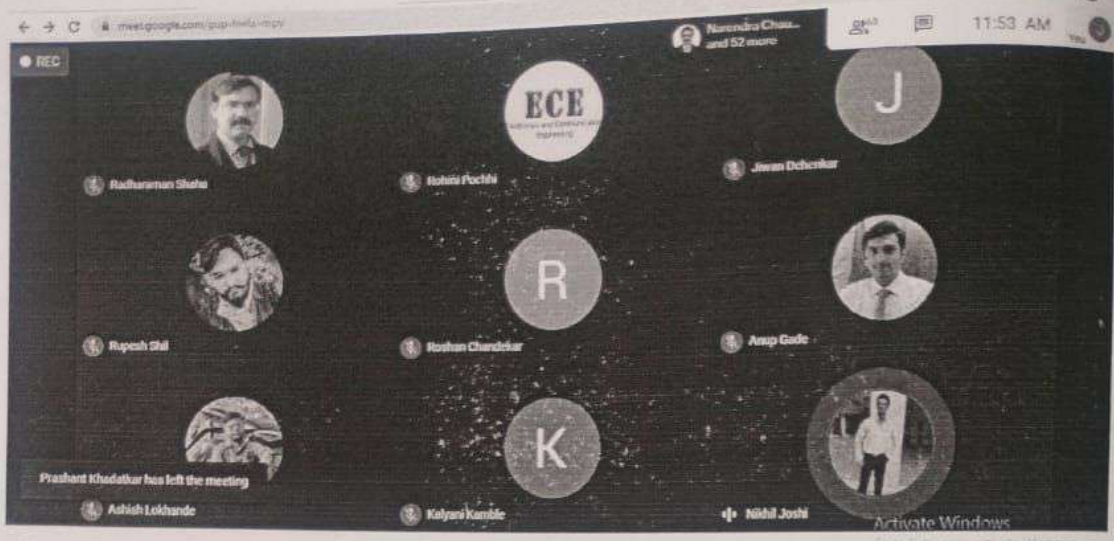
Conclusion:

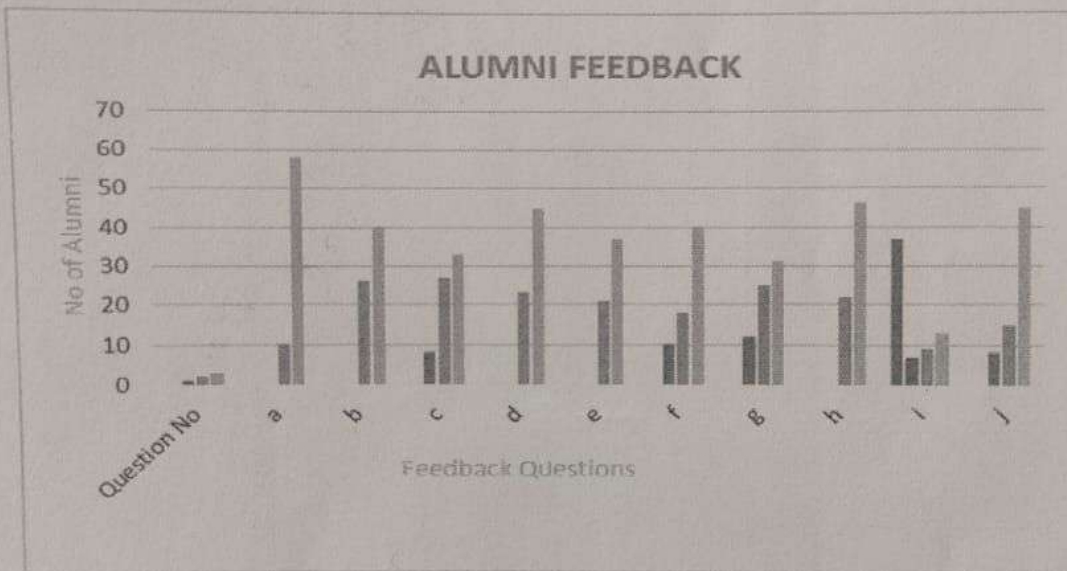




